

# Neath Leisure Centre

The Neath Leisure pool was a traditional 33 metre swimming pool. In 1993 the pool was refurbished. A flume, waterfall, mushroom, water canon and bubblers were added as well as a 25 metre 6 lane competition pool. Calcium hypochlorite and carbon dioxide were used for water treatment.



On reopening, staff were experiencing breathing difficulties and severe discomfort to their eyes, nose and throat. Some had been prescribed inhalers to try to overcome the problem.

Extensive corrosion problems were already occurring to stainless steel fittings, bolts and supports. In August 1993 the pool was switched to the POOLCURE System and since then all the aforementioned problems have been eliminated.

- ✓ The breathing difficulties stopped within a week.
- ✓ The corrosion of stainless steel fittings stopped.
- ✓ All carbon dioxide was saved.
